HOW TO USE

SURFACE PREPARATION

- Examine glass surfaces intended to receive new film and verify that they are free from defects and imperfections, which will affect the final appearance and potentially the as-installed performance. Correct all deficiencies before starting film application.
- A clean and dust-free work area should be provided when the films are installed





Safety & Security Window Film - SWF™

CUTTING

 Measure your window and add 25 mm extra to width and height for trimming. Unroll film liner-side up, mark, and cut on a clean flat surface.

APPLICATION

- Before applying each piece to its corresponding window, a soapy water solution will need to be sprayed across the glass. This will make it easier to manipulate and position the film as needed until it's perfectly in place.
- Put the film on the window with the adhesive side facing it. Once the film has been placed, it will need to be smoothed out with a squeegee-like tool to remove any air bubbles or wrinkles, no matter how minor.
- Once the SWF[™] security film has been applied, positioned, and smoothed over, it's time to trim away any excess film that doesn't fit perfectly with the window.

STORAGE

Safety and security window film should be stored in its original packaging, horizontally, away from direct sunlight, and at a temperature of around 21°C with 40-50% relative humidity.
